The intersectional theory of Reproductive Justice (RJ) is described as the complete physical, mental, spiritual, political, social, environmental and economic well-being of women and girls, based on the full achievement and protection of women's human rights.



The RJ framework is grounded in organizing women and girls to change structural power and inequalities.

RJ builds the engagement and leadership of the women who experience the greatest reproductive health disparities, including women of color, low-income, young, rural, immigrant, and incarcerated women, and LGBT people.

It asserts that an effective movement requires a base and leadership that reflects the diversity of our communities; and that the leadership and expertise of those most impacted by reproductive injustice is essential to winning policy change that benefits those with the greatest need.
